Forum Overview

In this session Ellen Wallace will present Woodnewton Primary's whole school approach to children's emotional, social and educational wellbeing.

The staff of Woodnewton Primary School place great emphasis on the service they provide for the local community and see this as an integral part of their partnership with their children and families. They believe that all children are entitled to a world class education that will equip them to become fully participatory members of society. They aim to ensure that their children have access to high quality learning experiences, where emotional well-being, academic achievement, physical development and high expectations are placed firmly at the centre of all they do. Theraplay® is integrated into the daily life of the school.

Matthew Reed, Chief Executive of the Children's Society, said "We need to find a way to make young people feel happier about their lives to avoid storing up problems for the future."

Ellen Wallace will show how Woodnewton Primary is doing just that.

Speaker Biography

Ellen Wallace trained at the Foebel Educational Institute in London. She taught in London and Leicestershire before becoming Headteacher at Woodnewton Way Infant School, Corby in 1991.

During her Headship, she has overseen several changes of school status, the amalgamation of the Infant School with the neighbouring Junior School, the integration of a Children's Centre and the establishment of a Designated Special Provision Nurture Group. In 2013, Ellen became Executive Principal of the Woodnewton Academy Trust.
